

**ZOTOS INTERNATIONAL, INC. Wins EPA Green Power Leadership Award**

Zotos International, Inc. (Headquarters in Darien, CT, an affiliate of Shiseido) was awarded with 2012 Green Power Leadership Award from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), honoring the company for its 3.3 MW on-site wind generation project.

The awarding ceremony was held at “2012 Renewable Energy Markets Conference” on September 24, 2012 in Washington, D.C. Ron Krassin, President & CEO, Anthony Perdigao, Vice President Operations and Chief Sustainability Officer received the award from Elizabeth Craig, Director, Climate Protection Partnerships Division, US EPA.

In 2012, Zotos met its goal of using 100 percent green power for its 60,400 m<sup>2</sup> manufacturing plant in Geneva, New York. Approximately half of the plant’s electricity is generated on-site with a 3.3 megawatt wind project , which consists of two 1.65 megawatt wind turbines that generate up to approximately five million kilowatt-hours (kWh) of green power annually. Zotos purchases renewable energy certificates (RECs) sourced from wind for the remainder of its electricity needs.

In 2010 Zotos began utilizing rail car to bring raw materials into the plant adding efficiency in transportation and reduction in CO<sub>2</sub> emissions. For example one rail car of raw material can reduce up to 40 intermodal truck load shipments. This small change saves time, money and reduces our impact on the environment.
